POLLY FERMAN AROUND THE WORLD



World renowned virtuoso pianist Polly Ferman is once again getting ready for a series of performances around the world. Her recent and upcoming schedule includes the following:

On February 16, she presented a recital of Habaneras, Milongas and Tangos at the Selecteum de Arts et des Sciences in Kaslik, Lebanon (en.selecteum.com/).



On February 17, she performed the same program at the American University in Beirut (shown at right) (www.aub.edu.lb/main/Pages/index.aspx), sponsored by the Instituto Cervantes.

Both programs were under the umbrella of the Uruguayan Bicentennial celebration.



The next stop on her 2011 tour is Buenos Aires for March 15, 22, 29 and April 5 performances of her GlamourTango. She writes about this, "I am really looking forward to the GlamourTango company's debut at the Maipo Theatre in Buenos Aires (at left). I created and direct GlamourTango, a multimedia show, with theatrical staging, as a tribute to the contribution women made to Tango. What makes it unique as a Tango company is the fact that it has an all female cast. – 22 women on stage, including a piano quintet (piano, bandoneon, violin, flute and double bass) the singer Valeria Lima, who will be special guest artist, 4 tango dancers and a troupe of 12 women candombe drummers and dancers. This is important for GlamourTango and me as its creator, as

May 14, Binelli-Ferman with the Quintet of the Americas at Symphony Space in Manhattan.

June 30, Mozarteum Argentino, filial San Juan, presents the Binelli-Ferman Duo at the Juan Victoria Auditorium in San Juan, Argentina

September 9 and 10, The Binelli-Ferman Duo at the Grand Canyon Festival in Arizona.

POLLY FERMAN IN THE RECORDING STUDIO

Polly Ferman has recorded a CD of the music of composer Daniel Binelli, with accordionist Antonio Peruch and the all-female Camerata Romeu of Havana, Cuba, led by conductor Zenaida Romeu (www.camerataromeu.com/).

They recorded Binelli's **Paris desde Aqui**, **Tango de los Cuadros** and **Images of Buenos Aires** (all with Polly and the Camerata), **Homage to Tango**- Double Concerto for piano, accordion and chamber orchestra, **Preludio y Candombe**- for chamber orchestra with piano and accordion and **Metropolis**, for chamber orchestra with piano and accordion. This is the first CD to feature Binelli's compositions exclusively. Polly Ferman recorded it with Antonio Peruch, a wonderful Italian accordionist living in Canada who asked her to record and perform with him and Camerata Romeu after he had seen some of her YouTube videos made with the ensemble in 2005.
